## Who Must File

The parent corporation must file Form 851 for itself and for corporations in the affiliated group. File Form 851 by attaching it to the consolidated tax return for the group.

## Affiliated Group

The term "affiliated group" means one or more chains of includible corporations connected through stock ownership with a common parent corporation. See sections 1504(a) and (b). The common parent must be an includible corporation and the following requirements must be met:

1. The common parent must own directly stock that represents at least $80 \%$ of the total voting power and at least $80 \%$ of the total value of the stock of at least one of the other includible corporations.
2. Stock that represents at least $80 \%$ of the total voting power, and at least $80 \%$ of the total value of the stock of each of the other corporations (except for the common parent) must be owned directly by one or more of the other includible corporations.
Stock. The term "stock" generally does not include any stock that:
3. Is nonvoting,
4. Is nonconvertible,
5. Is limited and preferred as to dividends and does not participate significantly in corporate growth, and
6. Has redemption and liquidation rights that do not exceed the issue price of the stock (except for a reasonable redemption or liquidation premium).
