Because most exempt organizations use computers to prepare and print their returns, we are not sending you a tax package to save the cost of printing and mailing. If you need forms, instructions, or other tax products, see *How To Get Tax Products* below.

IMPORTANT: For 2009, exempt organizations that are not private foundations, and have gross receipts greater than \$25,000 but less than \$500,000 and assets less than \$1.25 million, may file Form 990-EZ instead of Form 990.
