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For the fifth straight year, eligible taxpayers can use the Free File site to prepare and electronically file their federal income tax returns without charges. There are no hidden fees. This program was developed by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) in partnership with the Free File Alliance LLC, a group of industry leading private-sector tax preparation companies.

Free File is available to anyone who earns \$52,000 a year or less. That's 70 percent of all taxpayers, roughly 95 million Americans. Free File is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, beginning January 16, 2007. The program is available in both English and Spanish.

More than 15.4 million tax returns have been prepared and submitted through Free File since it debuted during the 2003 filing season.

To use Free File, individuals must first go to the IRS website, **www.irs.gov**, click on "Free File", then press the "Start Now" button and choose a tax preparation company from the list provided. (Free File is not available by going directly to a company's website.) Not all companies offer services to everyone. Filers should be sure to read the offer description to find which company best fits the taxpayer's individual needs. Once a company is selected, users click on the link to that company's website and begin preparing their return. Free File also has a "Guide Me to a Company" feature that will assist taxpayers in selecting a company that offers services tailored to their particular situation.

Although Free File is available only for federal income tax returns, some participating Free File Alliance companies also offer state tax return preparation and e-filing at no charge. Those services are noted in the Free File section of those companies' websites.

Some alliance companies will also provide free access to Form 1040EZ-T for those people who have no legal obligation to file a tax return but who can request the one-time telephone excise tax refund. In addition, taxpayers can use Free File to file a Form 4868, Application for Automatic Extension of Time to File.

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Free File is fast, easy and safe. To use the program, just follow these five steps:

- 1. Go to the IRS website www.irs.gov click on "Free File" and press the "Start Now" button

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Description

The Free File program is a free federal tax preparation and electronic filing program for eligible taxpayers developed through a partnership between the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the Free File Alliance, a group of private sector tax preparation companies.

Purpose

Free File allows taxpayers earning \$52,000 or less to file their **federal** tax returns for free — that means no cost and no hidden fees. Qualified taxpayers must enter the Free File program through the IRS website at **www.irs.gov**. While Free File partners are allowed to charge a fee for state returns, some also offer free state filing. Check with your Free File partner to see if you can file your state taxes for free, as well. Use the "Guide Me to A Company" tool on **www.irs.gov** to determine which partners offer state tax preparation and e-filing services for your state. Fees for filing state income tax returns may apply.

Eligibility

Those who earned \$52,000 or less in 2006 may use Free File this year. That means 70 percent of all taxpayers – 95 million Americans – can take advantage of the program.

Program Benefits

Free File is fast, easy and safe to use. Also, you will receive a quicker refund when you submit your return electronically. The software programs are constantly updated to give you the most up to date information to complete your return accurately.

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What is Free File?

Free File is a free federal income tax preparation and electronic filing program for eligible taxpayers, developed through a partnership between the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the Free File Alliance. The Alliance consists of private sector tax preparation companies.

For 2007, individuals who earn \$52,000 or less may take advantage of the Free File program. This means 70 percent of all taxpayers — 95 million people — are eligible to Free File. Taxpayers can access the program starting in mid-January 2007 and it is available in English and Spanish.

Who is Eligible to Use Free File?

Free File is available to taxpayers who earned \$52,000 or less in 2006.

Is the Free File Program Really Free?

Yes, the Free File program is 100% free for qualifying taxpayers to electronically file their **federal** income taxes. There are no hidden fees or software costs. Taxpayers must enter through the IRS website, **www.irs.gov** to use Free File.

What are the Benefits of Using Free File?

Using Free File is fast, easy and safe. Those who meet the income requirement may file their federal income taxes completely **FREE** of charge. The program is available online 24 hours a day, seven days a week. With Free File refunds come faster, in half the time. For example, when you use Free File and choose to receive your refund with Direct Deposit, you will receive your refund in as little as 10 days.

Is Free File Secure?

Yes, Free File uses proprietary software approved by the IRS and your federal tax return is transmitted through the established IRS e-file

system using secure technologies. After you send your return, you will receive an email from the IRS to let you know that it was accepted or rejected.

In addition, each tax preparation company offering Free File must attain a third-party privacy and security certification, as well as comply with all federal rules and regulations on taxpayer privacy. For example, these rules prohibit the use of tax return data for purposes not specifically authorized by the taxpayer. Lastly, the IRS monitors each company to make sure that it meets the privacy and security regulations.

Is Free File Easy to Use?

Free File is easy to use! It includes a "Free File Wizard" that will guide you through the program. Since Free File's debut in 2003, more than 15.4 million returns have been made through the program. Of those who have used Free File, 96% rated the program as "easy to use" and 97% said they would recommend it to a friend or family member.

Can I Download the Tax Software to Prepare my Return?

The Free File program does not use downloadable software. It is an internet based tax preparation program. All of the software is maintained on the individual company websites.

Which Tax Preparation and Filing Companies Offer Free File?

Free File is offered by nationally-known tax preparation companies. For a full list, visit **www.irs.gov**. The Free File "offer" page assists taxpayers in locating software companies that best suit their needs.

If you have trouble choosing a company after scanning the list, you may use the Free File Wizard interactive help tool, "Guide Me To A Company," to help narrow your search.

Frequently Asked Questions



How Do I Use Free File?

To use Free File, you must first go to the IRS website — www.irs.gov — and click on Free File.

Once you have reached the Free File page on you will find helpful information to assist you with filing your federal income tax return. Click the "Start Now" button to review the list of software companies and select one that best suits your needs. Once you select a company, you will be taken directly to that company's website to begin filing your federal tax return. Remember you must access the company through the IRS website to use Free File.

May I Also File My State Income Tax Return for Free?

Some participating Free File Alliance companies offer free state tax return preparation and e-filing services. You must check the company's Free File section of their website for more information because not all companies offer free state tax return services. You can use the "Guide Me to A Company" tool on **www.irs.gov** to determine which companies offer state tax preparation and e-filing services for your state. Fees for filing state income tax returns may apply.

What Happens if I Find My Income is More than \$52,000?

If, when using the Free File program, you find that your adjusted gross income exceeds \$52,000, then you will not be eligible to file your taxes for free. In that case, you may continue completing your return, but you will incur the tax preparation company's standard filing fee.

If I Have a Balance Due on My Return, Is There a Fee to Pay My Taxes?

You may pay your taxes for a Free File return just as you would a paper or any other electronically filed return. You can pay by check, money order, Electronic Federal Tax Payment System (EFTPS) or credit card. If you pay your balance due by credit card, there may be a "convenience fee" attached to this transaction.

Are There any Additional Costs?

Before starting your return using Free File, carefully review the tax preparation company's criteria to confirm that you meet their eligibility for preparing and e-filing your federal tax return for free. While you may choose to do so, you are under no obligation to buy any of the company's other products or services. Note that starting in 2007, all Alliance partners have agreed to remove ancillary offerings, such as Refund Anticipation Loans (RALs), from the Free File program.

Can I Use Free File if I File an Extension?

Yes, you can use Free File if you file for an extension. Free File is available until mid-October 2007.

Can I Use Free File Without a Computer?

Free File is an electronic program that uses the Internet. If you don't have access to a computer at home or work consider using a computer at your local library or senior center.

What Information will the IRS Collect or Retain on Me from Using Free File?

The information you provide through the "Guide Me To A Company" button is only used to determine the free services for which you may qualify. The information is entirely anonymous and will not be retained or used for any determination of tax liability. IRS policy prohibits the use of permanent Internet "cookies." In order to assist or identify you to make certain you are the correct recipient of information requested, the IRS may use "temporary" or "session" cookies, but these are deleted when your Internet visit ends. No information about you is maintained as a result of a temporary or session cookie.

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Can I Get My Federal Telephone Excise Tax Refund through Free File?

Yes. Some Free File Alliance companies will provide free access to Form 1040EZ-T for those eligible fliers who are not required to file a tax return, but want to request the one-time telephone excise tax refund. The telephone tax refund is a one-time payment available on your 2006 federal income tax return, designed to refund previously collected federal excise taxes on long-distance or bundled services. The IRS will refund the taxes you paid on long-distance or bundled service billed after Feb. 28, 2003 and before Aug. 1, 2006. More information about the Telephone Excise Tax refund can be found at **www.irs.gov**.
